Please be advised that the Ministry of Forests Lands and Natural Resource Operations will be commencing operations on several bridge replacement and road improvement projects on the Head Bay FSR. Project details and approximate timeframes are as follows:

- 47.3km Tlupana Creek #4, this project will involve replacing the existing bridge with a large culvert and will also involve some blasting and hauling of material from the project site to improve the alignment and sightlines at this location. Works should commence in late April and carry through until the end of May and will also involve the delivery of rip rap and some bridge approach works at the following 2 project sites:
- 27.5km Leagh Creek, this project will involve replacing the existing bridge with a new bridge
- 10.5km Perry River, this project will also involve replacing the existing bridge with a new bridge

Timing of the Leagh Creek and Perry River bridge replacements will take place between June 15 and September 15. **Bypasses with temporary crossings will be installed at each project site prior to works commencing to accommodate traffic.** Expect construction delays but no road closures are anticipated.
