Annual Policing Report Jan - Dec, 2016

The following policing report has been reviewed for a final account of the Nootka Sound Detachment Policing duties for Q1 through Q4. During the year the Nootka Sound RCMP responded to 126 calls for service in Tahsis. As expected in the busy summer months the third quarter saw a slight increase as police received 47 calls for service. And while it was a busy summer the majority of the calls were non emergency matters and included several assistance to Conservation (animal calls), False alarms and False 911 calls.

In keeping with our traffic initiative to promote safer roads, we have increased our patrols and enforcement within Tahsis as well as on the Head Bay Road. This included police roadblocks and multi agency checkstops with Department of Fisheries (DFO) and BC Conservation. I am pleased to report that the members were very well received and yielded very positive results such as two impaired (by drug) investigations. Collectively these initiatives helps reduce impaired related events on our roads as well as continue to deter poaching and illegal hunting/fishing practices that plague our communities in the past.

There was a slight increase in the busy summer months that included noise complaints from temporary renters as well as some property crime. I have met with Mark Tatchell to discuss our concerns and potential intervention options and look forward to proactively tackling this issue together.

From a community perspective, we remain engaged in the schools, participated in several community events and gatherings such as the Tahsis and look forward to a "stronger" showing this year.
