Good afternoon stakeholders,  
 over the next few weeks, Mainroad North Island crews will be performing all sorts of maintenance work as follows:

~ Machine Brushing on BCHwy 19, 28, Head Bay Road, and 19N as well as various rural subdivisions. Crews are working from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. Motorists watch for continual slow moving vehicles. This work

began yesterday and will be ongoing for the next 3-4 weeks.

~ Shoulder Maintenance on BC Hwys 19A, 28, and service area Campbell River bus routes. Crews are working from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm. Motorists watch for continual slow moving vehicles. This work began early this week and will continue into early next week.

~ Dangerous Tree Removal and improving sightlines for motorists is underway on BC Hwy 19N and Roberts Lake yesterday as well as Western Mines Road. Crews are working from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Single lane alternating with 20 min road closures will be in effect. This work will continue until early next week.

Motorists, please watch for our crews working roadside and obey traffic control so we can all return home safely to our families.
