



TAHSIS SEA LEVEL RISE AND FLOODPLAIN MAPPING PROJECT

PUBLIC MEETING

At this second public meeting, new floodplain and sea level rise maps will be displayed showing projected 20 year and beyond flood events and the consequences of rising sea levels. The project team from McElhanney Consulting Services Ltd. will present this information in animation so residents will be able to clearly visualize the areas of the Village which will be impacted by floods, storm surges, sea level rise and other related events.

With funding from the provincial government, the Village is mapping the areas which will be affected by these events and preparing policy and planning recommendations for future action, including zoning changes and structural mitigation measures.
