The following burning ban information was sent to the public today.

Burning ban takes effect at noon on July 18, 2018

SUMMARY

The Village of Tahsis is placing a full ban on open fires beginning at noon on Wednesday, July 18. This ban comes at the same time of the Province of British Columbia's campfire ban, which goes into effect July 18.

This open fire ban includes all outdoor wood fires such as campfires and cooking fires. Sky lanterns and tiki torches are also not permitted.

The following are permitted:

Cooking devices fueled by propane, natural gas, naphtha, kerosene, charcoal briquettes or electricity such as barbecues, grills, smokers, and portable or fixed campfire devices. It is important to ensure briquettes are fully extinguished after use.
