Jude was born in Halifax Nova Scotia to a Navy father and a stay at home mother with an older sister and brother. Due to her father's job the family was constantly on the move during her early years. These travels extended from England to Victoria with many stops in between. The family finally settled in Victoria where Jude finished her schooling. She met Scott in 1978 and they were married in March 1979. They worked and sailed up and down the coast before settling in Terrace.
