



# **TAHSIS SEA LEVEL RISE AND FLOODPLAIN MAPPING PROJECT**

## **PUBLIC MEETING**

By the year 2100 the seas in coastal British Columbia will have risen one meter from current levels. Sea level rise combined with other climate change events like flooding and storm surges through increased rainfall pose significant risks to the Village of Tahsis.

With funding from the provincial government, the Village is mapping the areas which will be affected by these events and preparing policy and planning recommendations for future action, including zoning changes and structural mitigation measures.
