New Business 1 RCMP Re: Introductions and discussion period

C/Supt Sullivan described how policing is arranged and delivery in British Columbia, the next phase of developing regional hubs on the Island and the human resource pressures facing the RCMP.

Sgt. Wiese noted that VIHA has hired a social worker, Kaitlyn Nohr, to provide services with persons dealing with mental health and addictions issues. Council requested to meet with Ms. Nohr.

C/Supt Sullivan emphasized the importance of reporting incidents to the police, even if it does not result in an immediate police response. E-reporting will be possible within the near future which will make it easier for persons to report offences or other issues to police.

Council expressed their overall satisfaction with the level of police service and the priorities of the Nootka Sound detachment. They noted that Tahsis receives more service now than when there were dedicated members stationed at the Tahsis detachment.
