Update for Visitors

The Village of Tahsis is welcoming visitors, with guidelines in place to keep our community safe.

Local businesses rely heavily on the short summer season which has already been cut short due to the necessary COVID-19 requirements. As B.C. moves ahead with the ReStart Plan which permits restaurants, pubs and other sectors to open safely, it is time for the Village to do the same. For those considering a trip to Tahsis, we ask that you:

- Stay at home if you have any symptoms of COVID-19
- Practice social distancing in public spaces
- Wear a mask if social distancing is not possible
- Practice frequent hand washing and use alcohol-based sanitizers

Local businesses have prepared safety plans following the guidelines from WorkSafe BC and other agencies, and we need you to follow these new rules when visiting. With Tahsis having very limited medical resources and a proportionately high number of vulnerable persons, we must continue to protect our community from COVID-19.
