



STREET LIGHT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Beginning April 12th, BC Hydro will start replacing all of its high pressure sodium street lights in Tahsis with energy efficient LED lights, as part of a province-wide project.

The installation is expected to have minimal impact on residents and businesses. There may be some short term lane closures or other traffic control measures when crews are working. No planned power outages will be conducted during the installation.

Tahsis Council has approved installing 3000K (warm white) for all BC Hydro street lights in the Village. The existing lights are 2300K. The LED lights will emit a whiter light than the current lights, which appear more orange. The replacement lights are designed to focus light downward towards the road and sidewalk and limit light shining upward to reduce light pollution.
