



FREE FIRESMART COMMUNITY CHIPPER

You are encouraged to FireSmart your property by taking wood debris to the end of your driveway by **9:00am on Monday, June 14th, 2021**. The debris will be picked up throughout the day, chipped and disposed of for free. No signup is required.

Rules

- *No rocks, no nails, no roots.
- *All “butt-ends” of branches pointed the same way so an entire bundle can be fed right into the chipper.
- *Tree trimmings must be under 16cm in diameter and 10m length maximum.
- *No invasive species such as Scotch Broom, English Holly, Giant Hogweed and Knotweed.
- *The contractor reserves the right not to pick up any pile they feel does not meet these rules.
- *Do not block traffic by piling debris on the road.
- *Any debris brought to the end of your driveway after the starting date may not be picked up.
