



Effective September 13, 2021, proof of vaccination (BC Vaccine Card) and one piece of valid government issued photo ID are required for persons 18 years of age and older to enter the Tahsis Recreation Centre.

Until September 26th, the following will also be accepted as proof of vaccine:

- Immunization record card given out at vaccine clinics
- Printed immunization record from Health Gateway
- National Defence Canada COVID-19 vaccine record or card
- Provincial Immunization Registry record
- ImmunizeBC record (used by First Nations Health Authority)
- Health Authority immunization records (Fraser Health, Vancouver Coastal Health and Northern Health)

Persons 12-18 years of age must show the BC Vaccine Card only.

After September 26, 2021 only the BC Vaccine Card will be accepted as proof of vaccine for BC residents to enter the Tahsis Recreation Centre.

Persons from other provinces or territories must show:

- Provincially/territorially officially recognized vaccine record
- Valid government photo ID

International visitors must show:

- Proof of vaccination they used to enter Canada (like ArriveCAN)
- Passport
