PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project will increase access to the Village of Tahsis by constructing a new, multi-purpose community pier and dock. The new pier and dock will provide safe and reliable marine infrastructure for residents, visitors, and surrounding remote coastal communities who depend on these facilities for access to school, transportation of goods, and recreation in addition to emergency access services, including first responders.

The project works include:

- demolition and removal of the airplane dock;
- construction of a new aluminum pedestrian access trestle to the floating docks.
- construction of a steel access gangway to the main float;
- construction of two new floating docks, accessed from the main float to provide moorage
- construction of a float launch float and shore loading crane for vessel loading/unloading
- replacement of a new launch ramp with improved performance for larger vessel and lower tides
- support services including fire suppression, potable water, and electrical supply;
