



TAHSIS FLOOD PROTECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT PHASE 2

In 2021, the Village of Tahsis received \$1.89 million in grant funding under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program to improve protection from flooding caused by the Tahsis River. Phase 1, which entailed improving drainage and diking, was completed in 2021. Beginning on August 14, 2023, Phase 2 construction will start. This phase will result in the height of the floodwall along the Tahsis River being raised using concrete lock blocks to protect the north area of the Village from 1:200 year flood events, as well as other related works.

Upland Contracting Ltd. is the prime contractor for this Phase. The work will require sections of the river bank being excavated and armoured with riprap to support the additional weight of the lock blocks. Pacificus Biological Services Ltd. will be onsite during the in-bank work as the environmental monitor. All work is being done in accordance with the approval of Fisheries and Oceans Canada (“DFO”) and with the support of the Mowachaht/Muchalaht First Nation Council of Chiefs.
