British Columbia is located in one of the most seismically active regions in the world with more than 3,000 earthquakes occurring every year. While most are too small to be felt, the risk of a major one causing significant damage is real.

A second Tsunami Warning Siren has recently been installed, funded through a grant from the Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM) to the Strathcona Regional District. The installation has been made possible through a partnership between the Vancouver Island Health Authority and the Village of Tahsis.

On Thursday October 17, 2024 at 1017am, The Great British Columbia Shake Out drill will occur. The Village of Tahsis will be participating and encouraging residents to be prepared for both large and small scale emergencies within the community. As part of this drill, a tsunami siren test will occur.
