



OUTDOOR BURNING PROHIBITED

All residents and visitors to Tahsis are reminded that Open Burning of yard debris and any other materials is PROHIBITED under Bylaw No. 516 between April 14th and October 14th annually. Burning permits are required during all other time periods.

Campfires or other small confined fires used for cooking of food on a barbecue or grill are allowed. A campfire is defined as a fire no larger than 50cm high and 50cm in diameter. The campfire must be well away from structures and other combustibles. You must have water readily available to extinguish the fire.

During times of increased risk of Wildfires, all burning including campfires may be prohibited.
