



Campfires Permitted

Category 2 & 3 Open Fires Prohibited

Effective at 12:00 p.m. (noon) PDT on Friday May 15, 2026, the Campfire prohibition will be rescinded within the Village of Tahsis and throughout the Coastal Fire Centre. Category 2 & Category 3 open burning will remain prohibited.

Current and forecast conditions have since shifted, bringing cooler temperatures, improved humidity values and an overall reduction in wildfire hazard throughout the Coastal Fire Centre.

Anyone choosing to light a campfire must do so responsibly which includes:

- Not burning during windy conditions
- Establish and maintain a fuel break
- Do NOT leave the fire unattended
- Ensure the fire is fully extinguished before leaving it
- Carry out fire control immediately/report to 9-1-1 if it becomes uncontrolled

In addition to Category 2 & 3 open fires being prohibited, the following activities and equipment are also restricted:

- Fireworks; as defined in the Fireworks Act;
- Binary Exploding Targets;
- Sky Lanterns
- Wood fired hot tubs, wood fired pizza ovens and other wood fired devices unless vented through a structure that has a flue and is incorporated in a building;
- Burn Barrels or Burn Cages of any size or description;
- Controlled air incinerators
- Air curtain burners; and Carbonizers.
